





Figure 3: Kidney Cancer: Bar chart of known combined stage by sex, Belgium 2017







Figure 6: Kidney Cancer: relative survival proportion by sex, Belgium 2013-2017




Figure 7: Kidney Cancer: relative survival proportion by age group in males, Belgium 2013-2017




Figure 8: Kidney Cancer: relative survival proportion by age group in females, Belgium 2013-2017




Figure 9: Kidney Cancer: relative survival proportion by region in males, Belgium 2013-2017




Figure 10: Kidney Cancer: relative survival proportion by region in females, Belgium 2013-2017
