BELGIAN VIRTUAL TUMOURBANK CATALOGUE ACCESS AGREEMENT

The steering committee of the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank grants access to the catalogue application of the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank (BVTc) to ... (name), ... (function) of ... (institution). The access is granted for a period of ... months via the User and Access Management of the eHealth platform, counting from the date of the last signature.

The access and use of the (coded) personal data of the BVTc only serves to localize the biological material that is available in the different local tumourbanks, and only for purposes of scientific research, as foreseen in the authorizations of the Sector Committee of Social Security and Health number 11/013 (of March 15, 2011, last changed on December 19, 2017) and number 12/025 (of March 20, 2012).

The undersigned future BVTc user hereby declares that:

- He/she will only use the BVTc for well-defined research projects on cancer that may potentially lead to an application for samples to the participating biobanks.
- No attempts will be made to identify sample donors.
- He/she will only access the BVTc personally and under no circumstances share this access with others.
- He/she informs the BCR in the following circumstances:
 - ✓ Access is no longer needed
 - ✓ He/she changes function in the institution that was mentioned in the access application form
 - ✓ He/she stops working for the institution that was mentioned in the access application form
- He/she is aware of the fact that a list with the name of the institutions who have access to the catalogue is publically available on the website www.virtualtumourbank.be
- He/she is a professional Health Care practitioner (preferably a physician) or uses the personal data of the BVTc under the responsibility of such a practitioner.
- The Belgian Privacy law of December 8, 1992 will at all times be respected.
- Will not use the available data in the BVTc for commercial objectives.

Any abuse of the use of the BVTc will lead to a permanent removal of the access and might lead to legal sanctions as foreseen in articles 38 until 42 of the Belgian Privacy Law of December 8, 1992.
